

REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES SITTING CADASTRAL ONLY COMPETENCY OF PROFESSIONAL ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

Note:

The following is to be read in conjunction with Appendix 1 to the Annual Circular - Admissions Policy for Membership including Competencies for NZIS Membership.

DISCIPLINE	COMPETENCY REQUIREMENT	PROJECT REQUIREMENT
Spatial Measurement	Column (b) of Appendix to Membership Policy.	No Project required. Candidates can expect to be orally examined in any of the listed competencies.
Topographic	Column (b) of Appendix to Membership Policy.	Candidate required to satisfy all of the requirements of paragraph "1b Topographic Surveys" (at page 9 of the Annual Circular) except that under paragraph 1b.6, only one 'Miscellaneous Survey' will be required.
Cadastral	Column (b) of Appendix to Membership Policy.	Candidate required to satisfy all competencies under column (b) of Appendix 1. Full projects as listed under "Section 2 Cadastral Surveying" of the annual circular are required to be submitted.
Land Development Engineering	Column (b) of Appendix to Membership Policy.	No Project required. Candidates can expect to be orally examined in any of the listed competencies.
Planning, Design & Resource Management	Column (b) of Appendix to Membership Policy.	Emphasis will be on statutory planning processes [rather than urban design and sustainability issues] i.e. Items 4.5,4.6, 4.7 and 4.8, of competencies listed under column (d) of Appendix 1. To test these, a project, either 4.3 Urban Development and Subdivision, or 4.5 Rezoning Proposal, as set out in the annual Circular p.18, should be submitted.
Geodetic	Column (b) of Appendix to Membership Policy.	No Project required. Candidates can expect to be orally examined in any of the listed competencies.
