Examiner Vacancies for the S+SNZ Examinations Panel

The Examinations Panel of Survey and Spatial New Zealand has vacancies for the following examiners:

- Cadastral Law Examiner
- Planning, Design and Resource Management Examiner
- Land Development Engineering Examiner.

These examiners form part of the Examinations Panel, chaired by Jo Johnston. The Examinations Panel is responsible for conducting the annual cadastral law exam and the twice-yearly assessment of projects and associated professional interviews to assess candidate competency in particular disciplines.

Ideally, examiners should have the following qualifications and experience:

- current professional membership of S+SNZ and for the five preceding years
- thorough understanding of the discipline
- broad and deep experience in the discipline
- assuring high quality work
- excellent communication skills.

Also desirable, is experience in supervising candidates' projects for S+SNZ Professional Examinations.
