2. REMITS FOR THE 2018 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

One remit has been received from members:

Post Nominals

That it be a recommendation to Council that its decision to create new post nominals under the name of Survey and Spatial New Zealand be rescinded and that the post nominals prior to that decision be reinstated.

Explanation:

The New Zealand Institute of Surveyors Incorporated (NZIS) is the legal entity that is the professional body of Land Surveyors in New Zealand.

In a bid to widen the membership of the Institute, the Institute Council adopted the marketing name of Survey and Spatial New Zealand and that is now used where once the term NZ Institute of Surveyors would have otherwise been used. However, the decision to adopt a marketing name did not alter the name or status of the legal body and that is still the case.

After consultation the council decided upon new post nominals based around S+SNZ to replace those such as MNZIS etc.

However, it is the opinion of this remit writer that being a member of "S+SNZ" is technically and legally incorrect. Survey and Spatial New Zealand is only a marketing name. The legal name of our professional body is the New Zealand Institute of Surveyors Incorporated. A person cannot be a member of a discipline or an activity or a marketing name. A person is a member of a professional body, in this case that must be the New Zealand Institute of Surveyors and the post nominals can only relate to the legal entity, the New Zealand Institute of Surveyors.

A number of members made this point at the time of the consultation, but the minutes of the council meeting shows that this point was not discussed when council was making its final decision.
