Continuity of Work for Members

- Work continuity is assured for S+SNZ. We use Layer 3 (based in Upper Hutt) for off-site secure storage for all our operational work files in Filecloud and Cyberglue Ltd (based in Auckland) for secure storage of our membership database.
- Staff at N.O are prepared to work from home if this is required. Filecloud and Office 365 allows a seamless transition to remote working and ensure continued service.
