**Affiliate Member** - Rule 6.1b.i & ii: Open to individuals enrolled in a course of study other than an Approved Course; or incorporated bodies and unincorporated groups; or any other interested member of the public.

**Associate Member** – Rule 6.1c.i&ii: Open to graduates of an Approved Course; or who have experience in Surveying and Spatial Science that satisfies the criteria set out in the NZIS Membership policy (Formerly Technical and Professional Associate categories).

**Voting Member** – Rule 6.1d: Open to individuals, incorporated bodies and unincorporated groups who meet the requirements of the NZIS Membership policy relating to Voting Membership. (Formerly Full Member category).

**Retired Member** – Rule 6.1e i & ii: Open to individuals who have retired from working in Surveying and Spatial Science; and were immediately before their retirement a Voting Member and/or who meet alternative criteria (if any) in the NZIS Membership policy.

**Student Member** – Rule 6.1a: Student Membership is open to individuals enrolled in an Approved Course.

**Overseas Member** - Rule 6.1f: Overseas Membership is open to individuals who are not permanently resident in New Zealand and would otherwise be eligible to apply to be a Voting, Retired or Associate Member.

#### 4. Voting Member

4.1 Applicants for Voting Member shall meet all of the following criteria:

a) Can document a minimum of seven years in total comprising of study towards a qualification recognised by NZIS Council plus professional experience or seven years of professional experience only if a qualification recognised by NZIS Council has not been obtained.

*Note: Professional experience means taking responsibility for work completed.*

- b) Can demonstrate expertise, responsibility and professionalism in their work by satisfactory completion of the NZIS Voting Member Application & Declaration which covers qualifications, experience, ethics, commitment to learning, understanding of professionalism,
- c) Has been nominated by one Voting Member or Retired Member (NZIS can appoint a mentor /nominator if requested).
- d) Satisfactory completion of a telephone or internet interview on the above information.

4.2 If the application does not rely on offshore qualifications or experience and satisfies all criteria, it can be approved by the CEO. Induction into NZIS will be completed by the National Office with support from, NZIS Branch, Division or Stream as appropriate to the applicants' location and interests. Where further enquiries are required with regard to section 4.1, the CEO will refer the application to the Membership Services Committee for a decision.

The Committee may review any application decision of the CEO.

4.3 The designatory letters of a Voting Member shall be MNZIS.
