**CERTIFICATION FRAMEWORK UPDATE** 



The project to implement a *Certification Pathway* has made steady progress throughout the year following work by Project Manager, Jayne Albiston and the Governance Panel led by Mike Benning. At their October meeting, the S+SNZ Council approved the new *Certification Framework and Assessment Process* to enter the testing and pilot phases. The pilot is expected to formally begin during the first few months of 2022. Mike Benning provided a framework overview at the Member's Forum prior to the AGM on 4 November. The *Certification Framework and Assessment Process* details the certification, application and assessment processes along with descriptions of the competencies associated with the initial two disciplines we are developing certification for - these are engineering surveying and land development engineering. The test and pilot phases will include consultation with members and other interested parties.



Both the April and October exams will go ahead as usual in the same format as they have in previous years.
