Certification Programme Pilot Underway

The Pilot for the new Certification Framework and Assessments of Competency is underway and will be completed just prior to our Annual Conference. The two initial programs included are the Competence Certifications for

Land Development Engineering and Engineering Surveying. May/June is dedicated to the certifying of Assessors. June/July is dedicated to the assessment of the first cohort of candidates. Progress on Regulation of Subdivision Engineering

In 2021 a submission was presented to MBIE - the ultimate goal to have Land Development Engineering recognised as a class of licence under a new regime being introduced. The regime is to regulate all those professionals practicing engineering of any kind, including Land Development & Subdivision Engineering that is practised by so many S+SNZ members.

Linked to the Certification Programme under development, this is piece of work is of enormous importance for our Land Development Stream members and other surveyors practising in this area.
