COMMON SURVEY REQUISITION ITEMS

A summary of the most common errors made on Cadastral Survey Rules 2021 datasets from 1 January to 30 June 2022 are detailed on the following webpage:

Requisition Items identified include:

- Pre-validation reporting
- Mark condition
- Mark description for PRMs
- Reinstated boundaries
- Occupation information
- Easement Schedule



Make sure these items are added to your quality assurance process, so you know what to look for.

DONUT PARCELS

Information on how to deal with donut parcels has been expanded on to provide more detail around when:

- only dealing with the outer ring
- only dealing with the inner ring
- creating a new donut parcel



Make sure you check out the guidance to get the topology right.



The additional content includes more examples from suppliers of survey instrumentation as well as tables of the content expected to be included in electronic field information.



The tables included cover:

- project details,
- measurement station details (from point),
- measured points details (to point).

These tables list field information details that should be included for GNSS, total station and other technology setups.
